#### **Celebrate Together – All Age Jubilee Prayer Stations**

These prayer stations are based on the URC Jubilee picture book, Celebrate Together.

You might like to have large versions of the relevant pages at each station (you could print out the PowerPoint slides), or even give everyone a copy of the book to use as they go round the stations.

Each station will have some resources to set the theme, resources to be used in responsive prayer and an explanation sheet for the station.

Station one and six need to be close to each other so that they can collect their shoes easily.

Station six – if using, wick candles will need supervising for safety.

#### Station 1. The Invitation

Station set up: Chairs, a welcome sign, table with Bibles, pens, candles (can be battery).

Print double-sided invitation sheets (blank on the back) for everyone to take and use (A5 or A6).

#### Station 2. Everything is ready

Station set up: Chairs, a table with party nibbles, a basket with extra place settings and balloons, banners etc.

Bin, Bibles, permanent pens, helium balloons, party blowers.

#### Station 3. Time to celebrate

**Station set up:** Chairs, a table with headphones and iPads or similar loaded with worship songs of different styles, a basket with musical instruments, Bibles, pens, large roll of paper.

### **Station 4. Sharing Stories**

Station set up: Chairs, a table with a large blank journal, Bibles, pens.

#### Station 5. Time to tidy up and gift bags

**Station set up:** Chairs, a table with party bags with gifts on the themes, wipe boards and pens, Bibles, pens, small blank cards.

#### Station 6. Goodbye and thanks for coming

**Station set up:** Chairs, a table with candles (batteries or wick with one lit and spills), Bibles, pens. Position near to Station 1 and where the shoes have been left.



Those of you who do not have money, come, buy and eat!


Come buy wine and milk. You don't need money; it will cost you nothing.

Choose a song to play on the headphones and take some time to sing, dance, play instruments or simply listen. If others are in this space, feel free to celebrate together.


Celebrate all that God means to you, remind yourself of times when God has protected, provided, or guided you.

Psalm 78 v 1 – 7 (International Children's Bible)

My people, listen to my teaching. Listen to what I say.

I will speak using stories.

I will tell things that have been secret since long ago.

We have heard them and know them. Our fathers told them to us.

We will not keep them from our children.

We will tell those who come later about the praises of the Lord.

We will tell about his power and the miracles he has done.

Choose one part of your story and draw or write it into the Journal.

Leave it as an encouragement to others.

Take some time to flick through and enjoy some of the stories collected in the book.

I wonder which stories you found encouraging?

Thank you for the good gifts that you have given me.


Thank you for meeting me here today. Help me to remember the things that are important,

Notice the things that will need tidying away.

Now it is time to go and get your shoes – look at your invitation as a reminder of the beginning of the journey.

As you put on your shoes, thank God for today and ask God to be with you as you move on.

God who is everywhere.


Thank you for meeting me here today
